### **MILLIKEN MAN SENTENCED TO 15 YEARS IN PRISON FOR PIZZA HUT ROBBERY**

GREELEY, Colo. – A Milliken man who pled guilty last month to robbing a Greeley Pizza Hut was sentenced yesterday in Weld County District Court to 15 years in prison. Sean Oliver (DOB 12/15/1988) pled guilty on July 21, 2010, to Aggravated Robbery, a class three felony and was sentenced this morning.

According to police reports, on January 13, 2010, Greeley Police Officers were dispatched to the Pizza Hut located at 4637 29<sup>th</sup> Street in Greeley following a call from a restaurant employee who stated the restaurant had just been robbed. Once on scene, officers found store tags and other evidence, including footprints, outside of the restaurant that indicated the robbers had walked to the restaurant from a nearby sporting goods store. Interviews conducted at the sporting goods store stated that a “suspicious” man and woman had entered the store earlier the evening of the 13<sup>th</sup>. A review of the store video tape allowed officers to identify Oliver as the “suspicious” man in the store. A warrant was issued for Oliver, and he was arrested January 20, 2010.

Oliver’s co-defendant, Tori Bell (DOB 7/28/1990) of Loveland, was arrested January 25, 2010, and was also charged with Aggravated Robbery, a class three felony. Bell pled guilty to the charge on April 8, 2010, and was sentenced to four years of community corrections. Her case has been re-opened due to a violation of her sentence; she will be resentenced on September 2, 2010.
