
WANTED DEAD

- Escaped Ornamental
- Perennial from Eurasia
- Flowers June through August
- Grows at 5,000 to 12,000 foot elevations
- Grazing animals do not eat this plant when other options are available
- Still sold in wildflower mixes and is transplanted despite it's tendency to displace desirable plants

Alternatives to plant: Native daisies, Shasta daisy, black-eyed Susan, blanket flower, or Purple Mountain Sun Daisy
