## Dyers Woad



- Cultivated in colonial times for making a blue dye.
- Plant acts as a winter annual, biennial or short-lived perennial.
- Grows in dry, rocky areas. Especially loves sandy and gravelly soils
- Flowers April– June with seed formation in June–July.
- Seed viability is around 10 years.
- Pear shaped seed pods turn from bright green to purplish black as the mature.
- Plants grow 1 to 4 feet tall.
