10 pts.	Toxic substances properly identified, stored & used Comment: (Corrected) Found quaternary ammonia sanitizing solution at the 3 compartment sink to be above 400ppm. Sanitizer, cleaning compounds or other chemicals intended for use on food contact surfaces shall not be used in a way that leaves a toxic residue. Chlorine sanitizer shall be between 50-200 ppm (100 recommended). Quaternary ammonia solution mixed according to manufacturer's instruction (example 150-400 ppm). Corrected by diluting solution to 200ppm.	28
0 pts.	Adequate handwashing sinks properly supplied and accessible Comment: (Corrected) Found no hand washing signage at the hand sinks throughout the facility. A sign or poster that notifies food employees to wash their hands shall be provided at all handwashing sinks used by food employees and shall be clearly visible to food employees. Corrected by obtaining signage at time of inspection.	10
0 pts.	Food separated and protected Comment: (Corrected) Observed employee at the frying station to remove contaminated blue gloves by pulling off gloves with fingers, instead of shaking off gloves. Single use gloves shall be discarded when damaged, soiled, when interruptions occur in the operation or when task is completed. Corrected by discussing with employee and by observing proper procedure.	15
0 pts.	Food contact surfaces; cleaned & sanitized Comment: Observed mold build-up on top panel inside the ice machine. All food contact surfaces shall be maintained clean and sanitary. Correct as soon as possible, follow-up at next regular inspection.	16
0 pts.	In-use utensils: properly stored Comment: (Corrected) Observed employee using single-use cup to scoop ice from the ice bin. All utensils used to scoop food shall have a handle. Corrected by discussing with employee and observing use of ice scoop.	43
