At least one employee that has supervisory and management responsibility and the authority to direct and control food preparation and service shall be a certified food protection manager who has shown proficiency of required information through passing a test that is part of an accredited program. Correct as soon as possible. | 02           |
| 5 pts.  | <b>Time as a Public Health Control; procedures &amp; records</b><br>Comment: <b>(Corrected)</b> Found uncooked prepared pizzas on speed racks with cheese and meat toppings at 64 F with no times marked. When 'time as a public health control' is used, procedure in place shall be followed including marking of time and discarding of food at appropriate times. Employee stated pizzas had been there for approximately 40 minutes. Corrected by using timers.   | 24           |
| 0 pts.  | <b>Food contact surfaces; cleaned &amp; sanitized</b><br>Comment: <b>(Corrected)</b> Found food probe thermometer not in use but stored in heavily soiled condition. All food contact surfaces shall be maintained clean and sanitary. Corrected by setting aside to clean at three-compartment sink.  | 16           |
| 0 pts.  | <b>Toxic substances properly identified, stored &amp; used</b><br>Comment: <b>(Corrected)</b> Observed one spray bottle of orange cleaner stored on shelf above food preparation table. Poisonous or toxic materials shall be stored so they cannot contaminate food, equipment, utensils, linens or single-service articles. Corrected by moving to chemical storage.   | 28           |
